

NTE PREPARATION COURSE OFFERED

Are you registering for the National Teachers' Exam? This five session course, sponsored by the Office of Continuing Education and Lifelong Learning in conjunction with Career Services, can assist you in preparing for the exam.

The Stanley Kaplan NTE Review course will be delivered right on campus, and will consist of twenty hours of instruction covering the General Knowledge portion of the exam. In the first four lessons, the instructor will address the different question types found on the exam, and will look at each question type in detail. Students will then try a few questions or portions of questions on their own. At the end of each section, there will be a short reinforcement test to strengthen what the student has learned. The last lesson is a two hour practice test for General Knowledge; the teacher will go over the answers during the second half of the class.
