Nov. 9. We hear from Bath, that the Ladies and Gentlemen there intended to follow the laudable Example of the Royal Family; and that Sunday the 29th Instant, is the Day fix'd for leaving off Cambrick. They sent their Orders every Post for Muslin, and look upon it as a Merit to be included in the Number of those that endeavour to save their Country *Three Hundred Thousand Pounds a Year*.

Nov. 10. Private Letters by the last French Mail brings an Account that the Pretender lay very ill at Rome.

Nov. 20. On Saturday last Money was sent from the Pay-Office in Broad Street, under a strong Guard of a party of Horse, to pay off His Majesty's Ships at the following Ports, v. z the *Prince of Orange*, the *Lyon*, the *Tilbury*, the *Superb*, the *Buckingham*, the *Burford*, and the *Grafton* at *Chatham*; the *Tyger*, the *Argyle*, the *Pembroke*, the *Faulkland*, the *Norwich*, at *Sheerness*; the *Princess Amelie*, the *Sunderland*, the *Portland*, the *Angela*, the *Kent*, the *Elizabeth*, and the *Lenox*, at *Portsmouth*; the *Norfolk*, the *Advice*, the *Depford*, the *St. Alban's*, the *Oxford*, the *Princess Emma*, the *Sarafford*, and the *Warwick*, at *Portsmouth*.

Nov. 21. Yesterday an Order was issu'd out from the Lord Chamberlain's Office, for all Peers, Peeresse's, Privy Counsellors, to go out of Mourning on Sunday next, the 16th Instant, for the Death of the late Queen.

Nov. 23. We hear that Sir Orlando Bridgeman, Bart., who was reported to be drown'd, is alive and well at Gloucester.

Nov. 25. Last Week his Majesty was pleas'd to appoint *Edward Holden*, Esq; his Majesty's Agent and Consul in *Aggers*, a noted Wealthy Merchant, who has resided a considerable time in that Place, and a Man of the greatest Interest and Credit, Without Exceptions, of any here, to succeed *Charles Back*, Esq; in that Post.

Nov. 28. We hear that *Horatio Walpole*, Esq; youngest Son of the Right Hon. Sir *Robert Walpole*, will be a Candidate for *Lynn Regis* in *Norfolk*, in the room of *Sir Charles Turner*, Bart. deceas'd.

Boston, N. E. March 12. We hear from the Bay, that Cap. *Gwyn* in a Sloop belonging to this Town, bound to the Musketo shore, was taken by the Spaniards, and that they have put 70 hands on board his Sloop, and detain'd him and two of his hands to pilot them where they think proper to go.

That a Spanish Sloop bound from *Warrumak* in the Gulph of *Honduras*, to the *Havana*, very richly laden, was lost in her Passage, the Men made shift to get upon a *Morrooned Island*, where most of them was furnished. That Capt. *Derby*, of *Rhode-Island*, who sail'd from hence last week, having Information whereabouts the Wreck lay, went to it and took up 7000 Pieces of Eight, 500 Pistoles, a Silver Tea-Table, a Gold Cup, several Crucifixes of great value, and sundry other pieces of Plate. Capt. *Derby* had also rais'd up an Iron Chest, supposed to be full of Plate, but being in a Boat and the wind high, he was obliged to let it go. He took the Spaniards, among whom was a Priest, from off the Island, and carried them to the Bay. 'Tis said there were three Chests of Silver left in the Wreck, which 'tis suppos'd *Derby* will make another attempt to obtain. He intends to sail with his Booby to *Hamburgh*.
