Note: In all cases, in order to receive credit for a foreign language, at least two years of that language must be completed satisfactorily.

E. and R. If Elem. Algebra is completed in Course Two, first year Commercial Arithmetic is not a required subject in the second year of that course.

Subjects marked "R" are required and subjects marked "E" are elective.

Under special conditions a subject may be taken in a year different than it is outlined for.

In order to complete any one of the courses enough elective subjects must be taken to give with the required subjects a total of 15 units.

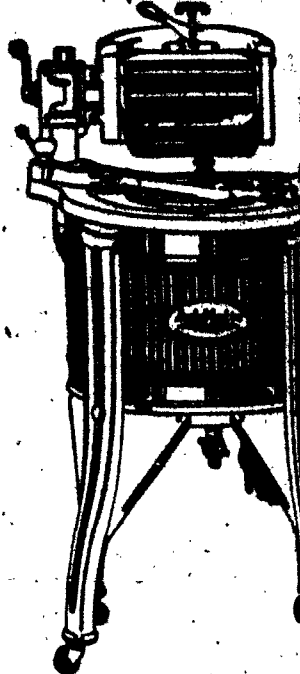
