CONDITIONS OF HIGHWAY

Following is the condition of the highways of the Province of Quebec as given in a bulletin just issued by the Roads Department:

1. Montreal - Sherbrooke Highway—96.36 miles. Good to very good. Resurfacing under way between Sherbrooke and Magog.

2. Montreal-Quebec Highway—188 miles. Good throughout. Laying of concrete at Pointe du Lac. Slowly. Detour at the plain bridge.

3. Levis-St. Lambert Highway—184.61 miles. Good throughout. Bridge under construction at northern limit of the parish of St. Asaph. Temporary bridge being laid with care. Aqueduct under construction in the village of St. Asaph du Lac. Resurfacing with gravel in the parish of St. Francois du Lac.

4. Montreal-Malone Highway—141 miles from Montreal to the York state boundary line. Good throughout. Widening of road under way at Tres St. Malachie, St. Malachie d'Ormes, Godmanchester and Ste. Anne.

5. Montreal-Ottawa Highway—122.58 miles. Good throughout. Widening works under way at Ste. Dorothee.

6. King Edward Highway—100 miles. Good throughout, except one mile at St. Lambert.

7. Levis-Sherbrooke Highway—139.62 miles. Follow route to the intersection of route 10, one mile west of Quebec. Good, save a stretch between Kingsey Falls and Kingsey Falls. This section is not under permanent maintenance. Bridge under construction at St. Nicholas. Detour by Station road. Resurfacing with gravel under way. Temporary bridge in Shipton. Slowly.

8. Sherbrooke-Derby Line Highway—33.87 miles. Good throughout.

9. Montreal-Rouses Point Highway via St. Jean—43.28 miles. King Edward Boulevard from St. Lambert to Laprairie, from Laprairie to the New State boundary. Resurfacing under way in the parishes of St. de l'He aux Noix and Laprairie.

10. Montreal-Valleyfield Highway—43.77 miles. Good.

11. Sherbrooke-Norton Mills Highway—80.89 miles. Good.

12. Levis-Jackman Highway—100 miles to the Maine boundary. Good throughout.

13. Lacolle-Knowlton Highway—61.86 miles. Good. Resurfacing with amiesite in the village of Knowlton.

14. Montreal-Toronto Highway—45.11 miles from Montreal to Ontario boundary. Good. Resurfacing under way at Dorchester.

15. Montreal - St. Albans Highway via Ibarville—54.78 miles. Good. Resurfacing under way from St. Lambert to the Vermont boundary. Follow route No. 14 from Laprairie and route No. 14 from St. Jean. Resurfacing with amiesite at Pike River, St. Athanasie and Ste. Anne. Good.
