R. P. H. S. Five Trims St. Johns Academy

The Rouses Point High School boys' basketball team overwhelmed the St. John's Academy quintet of Plattsburgh, by a 43 to 11 score on the local school court last Friday night in a game that was conspicuous more for its ragged, erratic playing and humorous situations, rather than any of the elements that go to make up an athletic contest.

While there isn't any question as to the ability of Chilton's crack R. P. H. S. outfit, the absolute ineffectiveness of the Plattsburgh outfit made it look like a real crowd-buster. If Coach Chilton had so decreed, the score could just as well been 73 to 43, or maybe even more. Every member of the Rouses Point squad participated in the game and the lack of real opposition slowed up the game somewhat. While George Hoag made 5 baskets during the time he played in the game he could just as easily have had as many more, for when he was under the basket and in possession of the ball with plenty of chance to shoot, he passed it back to give someone else a chance.

So ineffective was the passing and ball handling of the visitors that the local players walked right up and took the ball out of their hands.

The score was 12 to 2 at the end of the first quarter and 22 to 6 at half-time. St. John's registered only one basket in the third period while the Rouses Pointers got 9 points and the latter scored 12 more in the final stanza while the St. John's boys accounted for three points.

TRUCK DRIVERS MUST HAVE 8 HOURS OFF DUTY

In response to numerous requests for an interpretation of the law regulating hours of employment of truck and bus operators, Chas. A. Harnett, Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, said:

"The Labor Law provides that the operator of a motor truck or bus who shall have driven the vehicle ten hours shall have at least eight hours off duty before driving again. Drivers of trucks and buses who rest or sleep on bunks or cots constructed on the vehicles do not comply with this provision of the law, according to Attorney J. J. Bennett, who has given an opinion in response to a request for construction of the term 'off-duty'.

WINTER SPORTS PROGRAM AT LAKE PLACID REACHES PEAK IN FEBRUARY

Lake Placid, N. Y.—Winter sports at this resort reach their season's peak with the February program announced last week.

High spots include the final try-outs for the 1936 American Olympic bobsled and ski (combined event) teams February 9-13. The athletes chosen on the basis of their performances here will represent the United States in the IV Olympic Winter Games in Germany next winter.

The bobsled tests will be held on the famous Mt. Van Hoevenberg run, where bob-racing history was made during the III Olympic Winter Games in 1932. Found to be in championship condition in the preliminary tests of the current season, the big slide will undoubtedly see new world's records hung up when the country's crack pilots "shoot the works" next month for the honors of carrying Uncle Sam's colors down the big ice chute in the Bavarian Alps in 1936.

The Olympic ski try-outs will be staged on Intervales Olympic hill and on a course laid out along a section of the 250 miles of ski trails that surround Lake Placid. Lake Placid Club's 12th Annual
