The past forty years have witnessed a prodigious growth in American farming. In 1840 our grain product was six hundred and fifteen million bushels; ten years later it had risen to eight hundred and two millions; ten years later still to a billion and two hundred and thirty-eight millions; ten years later yet to a billion and three hundred and eighty-seven millions; and nine years later, or last year, to two billions four hundred and thirty-one millions. These annual cereal products have risen from a value of four billion dollars in 1850 to one of eleven billion dollars in 1870, and probably to one of fifteen billions or more in this past year, 1880 and the surplus, after paying wages and expenses, was over two billion dollars in 1870, and perhaps three billions in 1880. Mr. S. B. Ruggles has been collecting these statistics for the Chamber of Commerce in New York, and they are noteworthy.

D. WYATT Aiken, representative in Congress from South Carolina just re-elected, proposes the following course for southern representatives: "I believe the south in congress should have nothing to do with party entanglements, but stand aloof until the time to vote, and then upon all questions of national importance cast a solid vote for what they believe to be right, regardless of the fact whether the issue may be democratic or Republican in a partisan sense. In this way we would hold a balance of power that would result in our being courted by both parties north, and enable us frequently to dictate terms upon important issues."

IN SPITE of the restrictions on account of the pleuro-pneumonia the shipment of live stock to Great Britain continues to increase largely. It is also stated that a company with \$1,500,000 has been formed in London for carrying dressed meat from America in the "Great Eastern" fitted up with refrigerators. The business of supplying England with beef will probably be a permanent one.

### An Americanized Parisian.

Mlle. Grey, the daughter of the President, affects American ways altogether, and will walk and ride alone, much to the horror of the aristocrats, and even republican papers of Paris attack her for infringing on long established customs. They tell some very amusing stories about the young lady, and the difficulties she encounters in carrying out her Americanism. For instance no respectable French woman goes on the street alone, either a gentleman (relative, of course) or servant must accompany her. A foreigner can defy this rule with safety, and every day you meet English and American girls by themselves, but their nationality is so evident that it protects them where a native would be insulted right and left. It seems that on a number of occasions that Mlle. Grey, when walking alone, has been accosted by her too gallant countrymen, but instead of losing her temper or being frightened she hands them a visiting card to enforce her statement as to her personality, and then begins to harangue them on the beauty and propriety of woman walking unescorted, and on the folly of a man presuming for that reason that she is not all that she should be. The novelty of this proceeding is unparalleled more striking because unparallelled in the annals of French history.
