

## Giles' Show 'n Go Car Show and parade tonight

DUNDEE—Tonight, Wednesday, June 30, the Giles' Show 'N Go Car Show and Parade is free and on tap for your enjoyment. Classics, customs, rods, sports, American and foreign sportscars and motorcycles are welcome. The show will take place in Giles' ShurFine parking lots, with overflow in the Methodist Church lot, all on New York State Route 14A/Water Street in downtown Dundee.

Early arrivals are asked to park in the Methodist Church lot, which will be available at 4 p.m. Giles' south parking lot will be open for shoppers until 6 p.m.; the north lot will close at 5:30 p.m. for show parking. Giles' Food Mart will close early at 6 p.m.

Entries will be judged in six classes: American Sports Car, Classic Car, Foreign Sports Car, Hot Rod, Motorcycle, Race Car, Sports Car and Truck. Additionally, a trophy will be awarded to the oldest vehicle present and those displaying vehicles will determine the Exhibitor's

Choice Award. Lots of door prizes will be awarded and 50/50s will run throughout the evening.

Music provided by Sheldon Gibson and food, beverages and snacks by local not-for-profit groups will round out the festive atmosphere.

At 8:45 p.m., participants will parade their vehicles around town. Cars will leave Giles' lots, be directed east on Harpending, south on Garfield and Edwina streets, west on Hollister, south on NYS Route 14A, west on Chambers, north on Franklin along Bridge to Union, then north on Washington, back toward the Village on Rt. 14A to disperse toward home. Those who wish to share a final tune-up tip or performance fib can reconvene at Giles' after the parade.

If you can't come down to the show, take a minute to wave at the parade cars as they pass down your street and cheer them along the route. See you there!

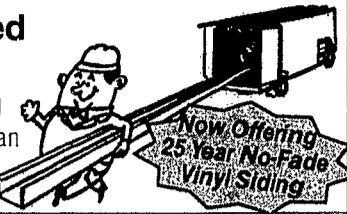

## Chamber to host Eggs & Issues

PENN YAN—The Yates County Chamber of Commerce is pleased to announce it will host an Eggs & Issues forum on Thursday, July 15 at Lakeside Country Club. The event will begin at 7:30 a.m.

The program for the morning will be a presentation about the planned Community Center. Amy Leisenfelder, recently hired executive director of Yates Cultural and Recreational Resources, Inc. (YCRR) and her Board will be on hand to fully explain the project.

The mission of YCRR, Inc. is to enhance the physical and mental well being of Yates County residents by promoting the providing cultural, recreational, athletic and educational opportunities. By cooperating with other community and governmental organizations, they will assure implementation and success of a Yates Cultural and Community Center.

The facility—expected to cost about \$3.6 million—will be open to all Yates County residents and is expected to offer programs for all age groups.

The YCRR has cited several reasons for the center, including extremely limited gym facilities in the area; limited convenient, affordable exercise facilities; few safe places for social interaction among youths; limited exposure to arts and cultural opportunities; and inadequate performance and rehearsal space.

Yearly operational costs are expected to be about \$450,000.

The village's boat launch site has been targeted as one of the potential sites, though no decision has been made on a location.

The organization has been "quietly" raising funds through private contributions, has intensified efforts to launch a capital campaign this summer.
