HOW TO REACH LAKE GEORGE.

FROM MONTREAL.—Delaware and Hudson Canal Co. R. R. south to Fort Ticonderoga, thence to Baldwin on Lake George.

FROM TROY OR ALBANY.—Delaware and Hudson Canal Co. R. R. north through Fort Edward, Sandy Hill and Glens Falls to Caldwell at the head of the lake.

FROM BOSTON.—Take Fitchburg R. R. west to Troy or Saratoga, thence north.

FROM NEW YORK.—Steamers Citizens' Line, West Shore or N. Y. C. and H. R. R. R. to Troy and Albany.

FROM FLORIDA.—North by Clyde Lines of steamers to New York city, thence north as above.

FROM RICHMOND.—Steamers of the Old Dominion Line.

FROM BUFFALO OR THE WEST.—East by N. Y. C. and H. R. R. R. or West Shore to Albany, thence north.

FROM PHILADELPHIA.—Connects with Susquehanna Branch Delaware and Hudson Canal Co. R. R., thence to Albany, or by way of New York.

The steamers of the Lake George Transportation Co. will land the visitor at any of the hotel piers.
