PROFESSOR BOYSEN DEAD.

Famous as an Educator, Linguist and Popular Novelist.

NEW YORK, Oct. 5.—Professor Hjalmar Hjorth Boyesen of Columbia college has died of rheumatism of the heart. Death came unexpectedly after an illness of but a few days.

The deceased leaves a widow and two sons. Professor Boyesen was born in Norway in 1848, in Fredericksvaern. He graduated at the university of Christiania in 1868.

He came to this country in 1869, he soon went to Chicago, where he became the editor of the Scandinavian paper, the Fremad. Five years after coming to America he published his first novel, "Gunnar," which was an immediate success and attracted much attention.
