**THIS WEEK'S RECIPE  
Smokey Baked Potatoes**  
(Serves 4)

4 medium potatoes, washed and baked  
1/2 cup hot milk  
1/4 cup smokey cheese spread  
2 tablespoons chopped parsley  
2 tablespoons butter  
1 teaspoon salt  
1/2 teaspoon pepper  
Paprika

Cut half-inch slice from top of each potato. Scoop out potato, but do not break skin. Mash potato and add all ingredients except paprika. Refill potatoes; sprinkle with paprika. Bake in a shallow pan in hot (400 F.) oven for 15 minutes or until piping hot.

Have some leftover rice? Heat and brown in butter with some mushrooms to go with the meat course.
