## HF-L tennis holds two wins

With nine players returning from last year's Section V Class BB title winning squad that held a 9-5 record, the Honeoye Falls-Lima Girls Varsity Tennis team has hopes for another good season this year.

Among the players HF-L coach Josh Bartolotta welcomed back is three-time Section V Class B singles champion in sophomore Quinn Gleason. Gleason is ranked 25<sup>th</sup> in the nation in the girls 14-and-under age category. Other veterans are seniors Chloe Farmer, Cara Farrell, Gabriella Izzo and Sarah Kaczmarek, juniors Laura Mueller, Ginny Tate and Teresa Weissend and sophomore Hailey Roth. Gleason was the All-Greater Rochester Player of the Year, on the AGR first team and a Monroe County All-League first team selection in singles. Farrell was a Monroe County All-League second team pick in doubles, Weissend an All-League second team selection in singles and Roth an All-League honorable mention in singles. Newcomers are sophomores Alexandra Gilligan and Brianna Kaufman.

HF-L opened its season in the Oneida Tournament in Utica on Sept. 4, a tournament that featured teams from the Rochester area, Albany area and Syracuse area. Each team had three matches with each match featuring three singles contests and four doubles contests as opposed to the four-single, three-double format used in Sec-

tion V. The Cougars dropped a 6-1 match to Shenendehowa from the Albany area with Gleason winning her match 10-0 at first singles in the 10-game pro-set format. HF-L edged Liverpool 4-3. Gleason again won in first singles by 10-0. Weissend and Roth paired up in first doubles for a 10-1 victory. Farrell and Farmer won 10-2 in second doubles. Kaczmarek and Kaufman battled in third doubles for a 10-9 (7-5 tiebreaker) win. The Cougars fell 5-2 to Fairport with Gleason winning the first singles by 10-1 and Weissend and Roth gaining a 10-1 victory at first doubles.

The Cougars roared past Eastridge 6-1 on Sept. 9. Gleason shut out her opponent 6-0, 6-0 in first singles. Weissend cruised past her second singles opponent by 6-0, 6-0. Roth netted a 6-0, 6-0 win at third singles. Farrell collected a 6-3, 6-2 win in fourth singles.

A pair of newcomers to the varsity, juniors Todd Alexander and Greg Buisman, teamed up for the second goal. Alexander served a good pass from the right side to Buisman, who knocked the ball in for a 2-1 lead in the second half. Brighton

tied the game. In overtime, Buisman had a great kick off a restart to Jim Burgasser, who headed the ball into the far post with 3:00 left for the game-winner. Jay Tallon made four saves.

HF-L (1-2-2) tied 1-1 with Victor on Sept. 16. The Blue Devils held a 1-0 halftime lead. Allan tied the game for the Cougars, taking a pass from Buisman and tucking it past the goalie with 16 minutes remaining in the game. Tallon stopped nine shots.

"Greg has made the most of his offensive opportunities," coach Mike Merrill said. "Mickey has also stepped up as far as putting the ball into the back of the net for us."
