"If a tree falls in the forest," goes the philosophical riddle, "does it make a sound?"

"Remove not, the ancient landmarks thy fathers have set," states Proverbs 22:28.

Another notable feature of Honeoye Falls' earthy, railroad-inspired, industrial zone has gone to the landfill. Beam Milling, on Lehigh Street (originally F. P. Jobs) is no more. Nearby, the mid-19th century office that was once M. & S. Pierce Lumber, will soon be next.

Like Newman's Luke, no one is comprehending; like the tree falling, no one notices; and, in this throw-away society, where the blood of heritage is watered-down by apathy, preservation in the name of posterity seemingly extends only to the tip of one's nose.

Novelist, George Santayana, inspired this soon-to-be-famous Stewism: "If you don't know the past, how ya gonna know the future."

As futures go, the inexorable vinylization of a notable chunk of Honeoye Falls is, apparently, ours.
