NATIONAL CREDIT.—Mr. Dillaye, in his magnificent article, "Resumption and Ruin," on 5th page says: "Gold is one of the lesser products of labor, and is so produced and handled as to become the limited instrument of the few. Coin is the the first instrument in the selfish oppression everywhere exercised by capital. National credit is the homogenous power every man helps to create, and every man is bound to support. Gold may be, and is, so manipulated by telegraphic order as to be entirely subject to individual control, and beyond the reach of business necessity. National credit is as immovable as the the mountains, as solid as the Alleghanies, always to be relied upon, and always unceasing in the power its munificence can bestow. Gold has created more bankruptcies by its fluctuations, by its tyrannies, by its subjection to foreign control, than all the wars,
