From 1967 to 1972 Mrs. Brown resided with her brother, Howard Holt, in Lowville, and since 1972 has resided with her niece, Mrs. Boshart.

Lowest In Survey

An exhaustive statewide survey of prescription drug prices released recently by the Vermont Public Interest Research Group (VPIRG) reported Kinney Drugs, St. Albans store had the lowest prices in Vermont of any chain-operated pharmacy group.

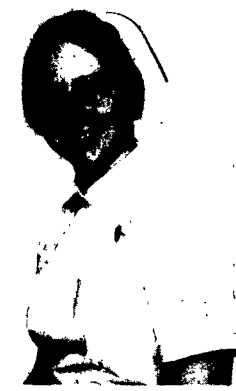
That conclusion was arrived at by totaling the prices of the 50 most commonly prescribed drugs - anybody buying all the drugs at once would pay \$245.79 at Kinney Drugs. The report showed the highest overall prices were found in Winooski, where all 50 drugs would cost \$371.28.

The survey, billed by VPIRG as "the most extensive prescription drug price survey ever conducted in any state," lists prices of the 50 most commonly prescribed drugs in Vermont's stores.

VPIRG Director Scott Shiner said the survey was done largely because of a favorable public response to an earlier survey of the Burlington area.

Particularly good response, he said, came from physicians and from elderly persons who spend large parts of their budgets on drugs.

When asked about the survey, M. Stanley Paupet, Kinney president, said the company's policy of low mark-ups on prescription drugs is in effect in Vermont and New York State throughout the Kinney chain. "We are pleased to have had the lowest prices in two recent independent surveys," Mr. Paupet said.
