be included in the program. Dr. Eichenfield and his family came to Baldwin in 1960 when he opened his pediatric medicine practice on Grand Avenue. He is a graduate of Brooklyn Tech (1948), Syracuse University (1951) and The Chicago Medical School (1955). Dr. Eichenfield did his internship

at SUNY Upstate in Syracuse and his residency at the Mt. Sinai Hospital in New York City. From 1958-1960 he was a U.S. Army pediatrician at Ft. Eustis, Virginia.

Dr. Stu, as he is best known, is a staff pediatrician at L.I. Jewish Medical Center and South Nassau Communities Hospital and attending pediatrician at Mercy Hospital. He has been a Baldwin Schools physician since 1961 serving as chief physician from 1976 to the present time. Dr. Eichenfield is also the physician to the Committee of Special Education.

His community activities include membership in the Union Reform Temple, where he served as vice-president, the Baldwin Citizens Committee and the Baldwin Educational Assembly. He was also the founder of Temple Emanuel of Baldwin in 1963.

Dr. Stu and his wife, Fran, have two sons and a daughter. Dr. Andrew Eichenfield is now director of pediatric rheumatology and immunology at Mt. Sinai Hospital. Dr. Larry Eichenfield is resident in dermatology at the University of Pennsylvania and a board certified pediatrician and Amy Eichenfield teaches math and science at Wantagh Middle School.

Their first grandchild, Matthew Abraham Eichenfield, is attending pre-pre kindergarten in Cherry Hill, New Jersey.
