Operators Console Tot 'Who Wakes Up With No One At Home.

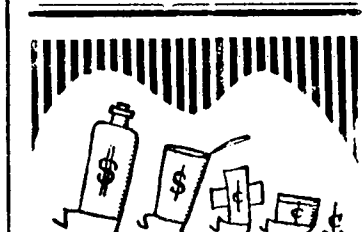
